In reponse to the brief calling for a sculptural intervention located on a prime corner within the golden mile, 'PROJECT STEAM' explores the formal idea of activating the site by creating a public open space that houses a subterranean gallery space. This is architecturally manifested through the notion of peeling back the topography in exhibiting the works of science, technology, engineering, art and mathematics. Ground level becomes home to a small coffee shop, the public space is activated through bleacher seats upon a cascading topography. Skylights offer the public a chance to peer down into the exhibition space, creating link between the public and private realms.
